

Service Guidelines

We are excited to resume in-person services on June 7th 2020. In preparation for regathering, we have put together the following guidelines. As you will notice, our Sunday gatherings will be different from the norm. While things will be different, we will still seek to glorify God, make Jesus' name famous, and reach the lost, all while gathering together in as safe a way as possible. Do you have these symptoms?

- Fever
- Cough
- Colds
- Headache
- Diarrhea
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Joint and Muscle Pain

Have you had Exposure?

- Travelled to other countries in the past 14 days
- Exposure to a confirmed COVID-19 patient
- Travelled to, reside, or work in local hotbed areas with reported COVID-19 cases
- Exposure to a Person Under Investigation (PUI) for COVID-19

With Exposure + With Symptoms:

- Do not attend service.
- Self quarantine or seek medical help.

No Exposure + No Symptoms:

- Feel free to attend service on your designated weekend. (See below for details)

With Exposure + No Symptoms:

- Conduct home quarantine for 14 days and monitor symptoms.
- If no symptoms develop, you are free to attend service after the quarantine period has ended.

****NOTE: If you are considered at risk or are not comfortable attending, please consider watching the livestream.*

How Will You Enter & Exit the Building?

- **Doors Open** - Doors will not open until 8:55 am.
- **Cue** - In order to avoid bottlenecks in the hallways, we are asking everyone to cue up outside the building. In the case of inclement weather, please cue in the gym (FAC).
- **Seating** - An usher will direct you and your immediate family to a seat in the sanctuary.
- **Exit** - After the service is over, please wait for an usher to come and dismiss you and your family. We will dismiss one family at a time.

What Should You Expect from a Facility Standpoint?

- **No Sunday School** - We will not have SS classes meet before or after the service in the church building.
 - **One Way Hallways** - Hallways will be oneway. Please look for directional markers.
 - **Bathrooms** - There will be one bathroom open. Please look for signage.
 - **Entrance and Exit** - There will be one entrance and two exits located in the front of the building only.
 - **Parking** - Please plan to park in the front of the building and on the side of the building. Feel free to park in visitor parking, but leave handicap spaces available.
 - **Food and Drink** - No food or drinks offered before or after service.

When Can We Fellowship?

- **Fellowshipping** - We ask that you remain in the seat in which you are sat before, during, and after the service. ie ***Please don't walk across the sanctuary to visit with another family.***
 - **Maintain Social Distance** - Stay at least 6 feet a part from one another.
 - **No physical contact** - If we all practice no physical contact, no one will be put in a position to either offend or break their personal social distancing rules.
 - **Parking Lot** - After you are ushered out of the building, you are free to visit and fellowship with others in the parking lot.

What Will the Service Look Like?

GROUPS *(Divided by last name)*

- **Group A** - A-K – Begin June 7th
- **Group B** - L-Z – Begin June 14th
- **Each group will attend every other weekend from the date listed above.**
- Please plan to alternate weekends until otherwise advised.

PHASE 1

- **Short service** - In order to limit time in the sanctuary.
- **No Childcare** - We will not provide childcare during the service. Families will sit together in the sanctuary.
- **Limited Capacity** - Services will be held at a limited capacity. You will be assigned a group based on your last name. We ask you only attend in person service during your groups weekend.
- **No congregational singing** - In order to limit aerosol spread, we will not sing as a congregation.
 - Praise band will sing, Scripture will be read, Prayer offered, Special music, and a Sermon.
- **No Time of Response** - If you have a need, would like prayer, or would like to discuss the gospel, please see one of our Pastors or a Deacon in the parking lot after the service.
- **Offering** - Offering plates will not be passed, but will be available at the back of the sanctuary.
- **Handouts** - No handouts will be provided.
- **Dress** - Please feel free to dress in clothing that is easy to launder.
- **Mask** - You are not required to wear a mask, but it is suggested.
